John Hatch Trainee Leadership Award

Purpose and Award Criteria

The John Hatch Trainee Leadership Award seeks to recognize and celebrate trainees who contribute positively to the Harvard Stem Cell and Regenerative Biology (HSCRB) community at the highest levels of impact and excellence. Contributions may occur in a variety of formal or informal capacities, including but not limited to:

- Innovative and continuous commitment to improving the atmosphere and productivity of the department, school, and university;
- Promoting an environment of inclusion and belonging through modeling behaviors and initiating actions;
- Establishing or fostering collaboration with other labs, schools, or industry partners;
- Contributing to Harvard's educational mission or commitment to sustainability; or
- Outstanding teamwork or mentorship.

Eligibility

Nominee must be a current student (graduate or undergraduate), post-doctoral fellow, or research staff member in the lab of an HSCRB faculty member. Both FAS- and hospital-based trainees are eligible.

Nomination Process

Nominations will be accepted from 8am on July 10, 2020 through 5pm on August 31, 2020.

- Your name, lab, title
- Nominee's name, lab, title, email address
- A short statement no more than 500 words explaining how your nominee specifically exemplifies the award criteria

One trainee will be selected for the award. The winner will receive a certificate and an award of \$500 in recognition of their contributions.
